34. Tender Evaluation

(A) Eligible Bidder

During the tender evaluation process **Non-statutory document** (document uploaded in **My Space**), **Bid - A & Bid - B** constituting the technical bid will be opened first and evaluated. The determination of Technical qualification status of a bidder will be based on the following:

- i) Scrutiny of Form 9 (NIT Acceptance Form) duly notarized**
- ii) Scrutiny of documentary evidence as per Form 1: Check-list, Section V of Bid document submitted by the Tenderers**

iii) Evaluation of Non spec indicators

In the Technical Evaluation, marks would be awarded to each bidder in a graded manner on the basis of the following indicators:

Marks secured in all the 3 (three) indicators would be added to determine the score of a bidder. The scores would be reduced to suitable values between 0 and 100, considering the highest marks obtained out of 120 as 100 and following the unitary method. The evaluated marks of each bidder would then be rounded off to the nearest integral value in the scale of 0 to 100. The rounded off mark would constitute the **Score of Non Spec indicators**.

iv) Evaluation of Spec Indicator

Bidders will have to arrange for a functional demonstration of the offered equipments on the notified date. The evaluation of the Spec Indicator will be made based on the reports of the functional demonstration of the equipments. The functional demonstration (i.e. onsite/offsite) of the equipment is purely at the discretion of the Technical Bid Evaluation Committee and its input shall be treated as corroborative in nature and will not be a substitute for technical evaluation of the document submitted along with the bid. The decision of the Technical Committee in this regard will be final. Functional demonstration of the offered model will be held at Kolkata only.

Bidder has to comply with all Essential parameters of the technical specifications except deviation(s) which will be considered minor & acceptable by the team of the experts to be engaged by WBMSCL to take working demonstration of the offered equipments.

A bidder will be considered technically qualified if,

- 1. Comply with i) & ii) and qualified in iii) & iv) above**

Financial Bids of the technically qualified Bidders would be opened.

- i. The Bid - C (Financial Bids) of only those Tenderers qualifying the above evaluation will be opened.

Comparison of Financial Bids would be based on the sum of 'a' & 'b' taken together as mentioned in "Submission and Opening of Bids" quoted by the tenderers.

34. Evaluation of Bids

(A) Technical Evaluation

During the tender evaluation process **Non-statutory document** (document uploaded in My Space), **Bid - A & Bid - B** constituting the technical bid will be opened first and evaluated. The determination of Technical qualification status of a bidder will be based on the following:

Marks secured in all the 3 (three) indicators would be added to determine the score of a bidder. The scores would be reduced to suitable values between 0 and 100, considering the highest marks obtained out of 120 as 100 and following the unitary method. The evaluated marks of each bidder would then be rounded off to the nearest integral value in the scale of 0 to 100. The rounded off mark would constitute the **Score of Non Spec indicators**. **A bidder will be considered qualified in Non spec indicators, if he secures score of 50.**

iv) Evaluation of Spec Indicator

Bidders will have to arrange for a functional demonstration of the offered equipments on the notified date. The evaluation of the Spec Indicator will be made based on the reports of the functional demonstration of the equipments. The functional demonstration (i.e. onsite/offsite) of the equipment is purely at the discretion of the Technical Bid Evaluation Committee and its input shall be treated as corroborative in nature and will not be a substitute for technical evaluation of the document submitted along with the bid. The decision of the Technical Committee in this regard will be final. Functional demonstration of the offered model will be held at Kolkata only.

Bidder has to comply with all Essential parameters of the technical specifications except deviation(s) which will be considered minor & acceptable by the team of experts to be engaged by WBMSCL to take working demonstration of the offered equipments.

A bidder will be considered technically qualified if,

1. Comply with i) & ii) and qualified in iii) & iv) above

B. Financial Evaluation

Financial Bids (Bid - C) of the technically qualified Bidders would only be opened. Comparison of Financial Bids would be based on the sum of 'a' & 'b' taken together as mentioned in "Submission and Opening of Bids" quoted by the tenderers.
