Amendment- II

Replace the following (marked as red)

3. Bid Evaluation Process

Technical Bid:

Marks would be assigned to each bidder on the basis of the following parameters and weights assigned to each for judging their technical qualification in relation to the bid.

1	Average Annual Turnover of the Company during the last 3 Financial Years 2010-11, 2011-12 & 2012-13 (Rs in Crore)	100	0.2
2	Average Annual Production of the Company during the last 3 Financial Years 2010-11, 2011-12 & 2012-13 (No of Bicycles actually manufactured)	100	0.2
3	Credential of Bulk Supply (Instances of supply of more than 2000 Bicycles in a single order) during the last 3 Financial Years 2010-11, 2011-12 & 2012-13 (Total No. of Bicycles actually supplied)	100	0.1

4	Credential of Bulk Supply to Government/ Government Agencies (Instances of supply of more than 2000 Bicycles in a single order) during the last 3 Financial Years 2010-11, 2011-12 & 2012-13 (Total No. of Bicycles actually supplied)	100	0.1
5	Servicing Network of the Bidder in the concerned area – to be evaluated by the Points of Presence of the Company in the 3 LWE affected Districts	100	0.1
6	Quality of the Bicycle - compliance of the sample bicycle to the technical specifications prescribed in the Bid Document –to be judged by a Technical Committee on the basis of the physical quality of the sample and the supporting documents (like IS certification) to be produced by the bidders.	100	0.3

Each of the aforesaid indicators would be evaluated on a scale of 0 to 100, considering the score of the bidder with the highest absolute value as 100, and reducing the absolute values of the remaining bidders to suitable values between 0 and 100 following the unitary method. All scores should be rounded off to the nearest integral value in the scale of 0 to 100. The weighted average of all the six indicators would constitute the Technical Score of an Agency. Financial Bids of the Bidders securing a Technical Score of 50 and above would only be opened to decide the award.

Replace the following (marked as red)

(g) Payment Terms: Bills against the supply will have to be raised in duplicate in the name of the WEST BENGAL MEDICAL SERVICES CORPORATION LIMITED, along with supporting documents including supply challan etc. duly receipted. Payment would be made from the Head Office of WBMSCL only after satisfactory completion of delivery of the requisite number of Ladies Bicycles, fitted with all fittings and accessories as per specification and obtaining certificates to that effect in the format prescribed at Annexure C, from the BMOHs concerned, duly countersigned by the respective CMOH/ Deputy CMOHs. Statutory deductions like Income Tax etc. would be made from the bills, at applicable rates.

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
