- Bidders shall quote only those products (Part of Service delivery) in the bid which are not obsolete in the market and has at least 5 years residual market life i.e. the offered product shall not be declared end-oflife by the OEM before this period.
- 4. Bidder's offer is liable to be rejected if they don't upload any of the certificates / documents sought in the Bid document, ATC and Corrigendum if any.
- 5. Bidders are advised to check applicable GST on their own before quoting. Buyer will not take any responsibility in this regards. GST reimbursement will be as per actuals or as per applicable rates (whichever is lower), subject to the maximum of quoted GST %.
- 6. Buyer Added text based ATC clauses
 - 1. Bidders may have to arrange for a functional demonstration of the offered equipm ent during technical evaluation of the bids at Kolkata, West Bengal only, if desired by the Tender Inviting Authority (TIA).

 - 3. **Experience Criteria:** Bidder should submit following documents of same / similar type of medical equipment in support of supplies made to Govt. hospitals or reputed priv ate hospitals for the period of last three calendar years ending December 2022:

- 5. Bidder should submit minimum average annual turnover for last 3(Three) financial y ears in letter head of chartered accountant with mentioning valid UDIN (Unique Docu ment Identification Number). The data should submit in a table duly signed and stam ped by chartered accountant.
- 6. Availability of Service Centers: OEM / Bidder must have a Functional Service Centre in **Kolkata** and have capability of providing service as and when required.
- 7. Successful bidder/OEM will have to ensure that adequate number of dedicated te chnical service personals / engineers are designated / deployed for attending to th e Service Request in a time bound manner and for ensuring Timely Servicing / recti fication of defects during warranty & CMC period.

14. Any wrong or misleading information provided by the Tenderer during submission of bids may I ead to summary cancellation of bid, blacklisting in WBMSCL for at least 5 years and forfeiture of E MD.

Service Uptime in Warranty

a. Working condition for a minimum period of 354 days out of a period of 365 days. (i.e. 9 7% Uptime).

b. Call Log by E-mail/Phone.

c. The response time to any fault should be not more than 6 hrs after call is logged.

d. Maximum Downtime allowed without penalty: 72 hours.

e. Time for rectification should not be more than 48 hours.

f. Penalty beyond 72 hours downtime & if standby unit is not provided: The percentage of 0.5% of the invoice price of each week or part thereof, of delay unit actual delivery or perf ormance up to a maximum deduction of 10% of the invoice price.

g. The adequate Engineers to be deployed for attend the all break down call raise by the e nd user.

15. The Tenderer is expected to examine all instructions, forms, terms and specifications in the Bidding Documents. Failure to furnish all information or documentation required by the Bidding. D ocuments may result in the rejection of the bid.

16. A prospective Tenderer requiring any clarification of the Bidding Documents shall contact W BMSCL in writing at procurement@wbmsc.gov.in

17. To give prospective Tenderers reasonable time in which to take an amendment into account in preparing their bids, WBMSCL may, at its discretion, extend the deadline for the submission of b ids.

18. Cost of Bidding

The Tenderer shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of its bid.

19. Language of Bid

The Bid, as well as all correspondence and documents relating to the bid exchanged by the Tende rer and WBMSCL, shall be written in the English language. Supporting documents and printed liter ature that are part of the Bid, if submitted in any other language provided they are accompanied by an accurate translation of the relevant passages into English and duly authenticated.

20. Prices quoted by the Tenderer shall be fixed during the Tenderer's performance of the C ontract and not subject to variation on any account.

21. The objective of this bid is to ensure supply of best quality equipment at the most competitiv e price. If at any stage of the bidding, including at the stage of financial evaluation, it appears t hat the tendered rate is artificially hiked or is much lower compared to the prevailing market p rice and available rates of similar or identical composition with the government, WBMSCL reser ves the right to cancel the bids.

22. Confidentiality

 \cdot Any effort by a Tenderer to influence WBMSCL in the examination, evaluation, compariso n of the bids or contract award decisions may result in the rejection of its Bid.

• Notwithstanding Instructions to Tenderers from the time of bid opening to the time of Co ntract Award, if any Tenderer wishes to contact WBMSCL on any matter related to the bidding process, it should do so in writing.

23. THE DECISION OF THE WBMSCL AUTHORITY WILL BE FINAL AND BINDING IN THIS MATTER.

a) Responsiveness of Bids

 \cdot WBMSCL's determination of a bid's responsiveness is to be based on the contents of the bid itself.

• A substantially responsive Bid is one that conforms to all the terms, conditions and specific ations of the Bidding Documents without material deviation, reservation, or omission. A material deviation, reservation, or omission is one that:

i. Affects in any substantial way the scope, quality, or performance of the goods and rel ated services specified in the Contract;

ii. Limits in any substantial way, inconsistent with the Bidding Documents, WBMSCL's rig hts or the Tenderer's obligations under the Contract;

or

iii. If rectified would unfairly affect the competitive position of other Tenderers presenting substantially responsive bids.

b) WBMSCL considers material deviation to include but not to be limited to the followi ng situations:

a. During technical evaluation of bids (verification of formal criteria):

 \cdot Lack of proper bid securities in terms of change in the wording (not consistent with the prescr ibed format), amount or validity period.

• Absence of bid form, change in the wording (not consistent with the prescribed format) or lac k of signature in the key portions of the bid form,

• The Tenderer does not accept important Contract conditions, i.e. related to Performance Security, Warranty, Force Majeure, Applicable Law, Delivery Schedule, Payment Terms, Limitation of Lia bility, etc.

• Specifications of the item quoted vary in one or more significant respect(s) from the minimum required Technical Specifications.

24. Domestic Preference

Companies based and manufacturing in India shall not be a factor in bid evaluation.

25. Financial evaluation

The financial bids of only those bidders who qualify in the technical bids will be opened.

26. WBMSCL's Right to Accept Any Bid and to Reject Any or All Bids

WBMSCL reserves the right to accept or reject any bid and to annul the bidding process and rejec t all bids at any time prior to contract award, without thereby incurring any liability to Tenderers.

27. Award Criteria

In the event of a Contract award, WBMSCL shall award the Contract to the Tenderer whose offer has been determined to be the lowest evaluated bid substantially responsive to the Bidding Docu ments, provided further that the Tenderer is determined to be qualified to perform the Contract s atisfactorily.

Before the award of Contract, WBMSCL may inspect the manufacturing facilities of the lowest ev aluated responsive Tenderer to assess his capability to successfully perform the Contract as per t he terms and conditions specified in the document.

28. Publication of Award of Contract

WBMSCL shall publish the Award of Contract in GEM portal.

29. Signing of Contract

- Prior to the expiry of the period of bid validity, WBMSCL shall issue Award of Contract (AOC). Th
 e draft agreement will be sent to the successful Tenderer along with the AOC and Special Conditi
 ons for Goods, if any.
- Within 14 (fourteen) days of receipt of the AOC, the successful Tenderer shall sign and return th e agreement to WBMSCL along with the required value of Performance Security in full as decided by WBMSCL.

30. Failure of the successful Tenderer to submit the Performance Security and sign the agreement

within 14 (fourteen) days of issue of AOC shall constitute sufficient grounds for the annulment of the award and forfeiture of the EMD.

31. The following penalties shall be imposed against offences mentioned against each:

32. COURT OF LAW:

In case of any dispute in between the parties, the matter will be settled in appropriate Court of L aw within Kolkata Jurisdiction

33. INSPECTION OF THE GOODS:

- All goods may be subjected to inspection and testing by FIRST PARTY or its designated rep resentatives at all times and places including the period of manufacture and in any event pri or to final acceptance by FIRST PARTY.
- Neither the carrying out of any inspections of the Goods nor any failure to undertake any s uch inspections shall relieve the SECOND PARTY of any of its warranties or the performance of any obligations under the Contract.

34. For goods supplied from within or outside India

a) For goods supplied from within or outside India, Purchaser retains the right to perform pre-ship ment inspection at the manufacturer's premises and an independent quality control laboratory testin g at its own cost.

b) The Purchaser will retain the right to perform further inspections and quality testing at any time till the satisfactory installation of Goods, as it deems fit, at its own cost.

35. Should any inspected or tested goods fail to conform to the specifications, the purchaser sh all reject them and the supplier shall replace the rejected goods free of cost to the purchaser, within a period of 30 (thirty) days of intimating such rejection

36. **REJECTION OF GOODS:**

Notwithstanding any other rights of, or remedies available to, FIRST PARTY under the Contract , in case any of the goods is defective or otherwise does not conform to the specifications or o ther requirements of the Contract, FIRST PARTY may, at its sole option, reject or refuse to acc ept the goods and the SECOND PARTY agrees promptly to replace the goods with goods of eq ual or better quality.

37. End of Life of the Equipment should not be less than 10 years.

38. Fraud and Corruption

• It is WBMSCL policy to require that Tenderers, suppliers and contractors and their subco ntractors under WBMSCL contracts, observe the highest standard of ethics during the procure ment and execution of such contracts. In pursuance of this policy, WBMSCL:

a. Defines, for the purposes of this provision, the terms set forth below as follows:

i. Bribery is the act of unduly offering, giving, receiving or soliciting anything of value to i nfluence the process of procuring goods or services, or executing contracts;

ii. Extortion or coercion is the act of attempting to influence the process of procuring good s or services, or executing contracts by means of threat of injury to person, property or reputa tion;

iii. Fraud is the misrepresentation of information or facts for the purpose of influencing the process of procuring goods or services, or executing the contracts, to the detriment of WBMSC L or other participants;

iv. Collusion is the agreement between Tenderers designed to result in bids at artificial pri ces that are not competitive.

b. Will reject a proposal to award a contract if it determines that a vendor recommended fo r award has engaged in corrupt practices in competing for the contract in question;

c. Will declare a vendor ineligible, either indefinitely or for a stated period of time, to beco me a WBMSCL registered Vendor if it at any time determines that the vendor has engaged in corrupt practices in competing for or in executing a WBMSCL contract;

d. Will cancel or terminate a contract if it determines that a vendor has engaged in corrupt practices in competing for or in executing a WBMSCL contract;

e. Will normally requires a WBMSCL vendor to allow WBMSCL, or any person that WBMSCL may designate, to inspect or carry out audits of the vendor's accounting records and financial statements in connection with the contract.

• Any vendor participating in WBMSCL's procurement activities, shall facilitate to WBMSCL personnel upon first request, all documents, records and other elements needed by WBMSCL to investigate the allegations of misconduct by either vendors or any other party to the procur ement activities. The absence of such cooperation may be sufficient grounds for the debarme nt of the vendor from WBMSCL vendor roster and may lead to suspension following review by WBMSCL Vendor Review Committee.

It is required that Vendors, their subsidiaries, agents, intermediaries and principals coop erate with WBMSCL Internal Audit Group as well as with other investigations authorized by W BMSCL or by the Government of West Bengal or the Central Government as and when require d. Such cooperation shall include, but not be limited to, the following: access to all employees, representatives, agents and assignees of the vendor; as well as production of all d ocuments requested, including financial records. Failure to fully cooperate with investigations will be considered sufficient grounds to allow WBMSCL to repudiate and terminate the contrac t and to debar and remove the supplier from WBMSCL's list of registered vendors.

39. Bidders shall quote only those products in the bid which are not obsolete in the m arket and has at least 10 years residual market life i.e. the offered product shall not b e declared end-of-life by the OEM before this period (10years =5years+5years CAMC) this period.

40. **Comprehensive Maintenance Contract (CMC):** The selected bidder shall enter into CMC after expiry of warranty and CMC should include the following:

- a) The equipment including all other accessories, ancillaries and whole turnkey work as given in the specifications of the equipment including UPS, UPS Battery, AC machines and furnitur e etc.
- b) Bidders must enter in to the CMC with WBMSCL directly / third party as authorized by H&F W Dept/ WBMSCL etc. Bidder must accept the same CMC rate, if the CMC is offered by the t

hird party/WBMSCL then no escalation, no extra cost will be provided. If any bidder failed to execute the CMC with WBMSCL or third party (as authorized by WBMSCL or H&FW Departm ent), WBMSCL may initiate legal action against the selected bidder. The selected bidder may be debarred to participate in the future tender

- c) The execution of CMC of any equipment will be at sole discretion of the WBMSCL managem ent.
- d) As per tender terms and condition third party items should be included within the CMC rate
- e) **Breakdown Calls**: as many numbers as may be required to attend to resolve the complai nt lodged by the end-users.
- f) **Preventive Maintenance:** The selected bidder should attend periodic planned preventiv e maintenances in the following manner:

- 7. Warranty period of the supplied products shall be 2 years from the date of final acceptance of goods or after completion of installation, commissioning & testing of goods (if included in the scope of supply), at consignee location. OEM Warranty certificates must be submitted by Successful Bidder at the time of delivery of Goods. The seller should guarantee the rectification of goods in case of any break down during the guarantee period. Seller should have well established Installation, Commissioning, Training, Troubleshooting and Maintenance Service group in INDIA for attending the after sales service. Details of Service Centres near consignee destinations are to be uploaded along with the bid.
- 8. Data Sheet of the product(s) offered in the bid, are to be uploaded along with the bid documents. Buyers can match and verify the Data Sheet with the product specifications offered. In case of any unexplained mismatch of technical parameters, the bid is liable for rejection.

- 11. OPTION CLAUSE: The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity by up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. Bidders are bound to accept the orders accordingly.

- 17. Timely Servicing / rectification of defects during warranty period: After having been notified of the defects / service requirement during warranty period, Seller has to complete the required Service / Rectification within 3 days time limit. If the Seller fails to complete service / rectification with defined time limit, a penalty of 0.5% of Unit Price of the product shall be charged as penalty for each week of delay from the seller. Seller can deposit the penalty with the Buyer directly else the Buyer shall have a right to recover all such penalty amount from the Performance Security (PBG).Cumulative Penalty cannot exceed more than 10% of the total contract value after which the Buyer shall have the right to get the service / rectification done from alternate sources at the risk and cost of the Seller besides forfeiture of PBG. Seller shall be liable to re-imberse the cost of such service / rectification to the Buyer.
- 18. The bidder is required to upload, along with the bid, all relevant certificates such as BIS licence, type test certificate, approval certificates and other certificates as prescribed in the Product Specification given in the bid document.
- 19. Without prejudice to Buyer's right to price adjustment by way of discount or any other right or remedy available to Buyer, Buyer may terminate the Contract or any part thereof by a written notice to the Seller, if:

i) The Seller fails to comply with any material term of the Contract.

ii) The Seller informs Buyer of its inability to deliver the Material(s) or any part thereof within the stipulated Delivery Period or such inability otherwise becomes apparent.

iii) The Seller fails to deliver the Material(s) or any part thereof within the stipulated Delivery Period and/or to replace/rectify any rejected or defective Material(s) promptly.

iv) The Seller becomes bankrupt or goes into liquidation.

v) The Seller makes a general assignment for the benefit of creditors.

vi) A receiver is appointed for any substantial property owned by the Seller.

vii) The Seller has misrepresented to Buyer, acting on which misrepresentation Buyer has placed the Purchase Order on the Seller.

20. While generating invoice in GeM portal, the seller must upload scanned copy of GST invoice and the screenshot of GST portal confirming payment of GST.

Disclaimer
