  - i) Name of work, ii) Name of Agency, iii) Amount put to tender, iv) TenderNo, v) Schedule month and year of commencement and completion as per the work order, vi) actual date of completion, vii) Gross value of the work done as per final bill.
- d) Payment will be made after getting the work done certificate & recommendationfrom the respectiveSite Engineer.
- e) The prospective bidders must have the credential(s) on similar nature of work and of satisfactory completion as a prime agency during the last 5(five) years from the date of issue of

this Notice as mentioned in Eligibility criteria under authority of State/ Central Govt., State /Central Govt. undertaking/ Statutory Bodies Constituted under the Statute of the Central / State Govt. The Credential Certificate has to be issued by the Engineer-in-Charge of the works not below the rank of Executive Engineer or equivalent. Credential Certificate must have include Work Order, and Work completion Certificate.

- f) Payment certificates in lieu of credentials will not be accepted.
- g) Valid up to date clearance of Income Tax return / GST Registration Certificate/ Professional Tax Enrolment/latest Deposit Challan / P.T. (Deposit Challan) / Pan Card / License / Voter ID Card for self-identification to beaccompanied with the Technical Bid Documents, Income Tax Acknowledgement Receipt for latest assessment Year to be submitted.
- h) The contractors who have been delisted of debarred by any government department shall not be eligible in anyway.
- i) Joint venture will not be allowed to participate in the above NIT.
- j) A prospective bidder participating in a single job either individually or as partner of a firm shall not be allowed toparticipate in the same job in any other form.
- k) A prospective bidder shall be allowed to participate in a single job either in the capacity of individual or as a partner of a firm. If found to have applied severally in a single job, all his applications will be rejected for that job.
- l) Where there is a discrepancy between the unit rate & the line item total resulting from multiplying the unit rate by thequantity, the unit rate quoted shall govern.
- m) Prevailing safety norms has to be followed so that LTI (Loss of time due to injury) is zero.
- n) No mobilization /secured advance will be allowed.
- o) Agencies shall have to arrange land for erection of Plant & Machineries, storing of materials, labour shed, laboratoryetc. at their own cost and responsibility.
- p) Constructional Labour Welfare Cess @ 1 % (one percent) of the cost of construction will be deducted from every bill of the selected agency. GST, Royalty & all other Statutory Levy / Cess will have to be borne by the contractor. As the rates in the Schedule of rate are inclusive of GST &Cess as stated above.
- q) In connectionwith the work, Arbitration will not be allowed. The Clause No. 25 of 2911(ii) is to be considered as deleted clause vide gazette notification no 558/SPW-13th December, 2011.
- r) The work is of URGENT in nature and agency entrusted for it shall have to complete the work within stipulated time without any failure.
- s) Refund of EMD: The Earnest Money of all the unsuccessful bidders, deposited online, shall be refunded inaccordance with the Memorandum of the Finance Department vide No. 3975-F(Y) dated 28th July, 2016.(Refer "Annexure-I" in Bidders Guideline).
- t) Penalty for suppression / distortion of fact. Submission of false document by tenderer is strictly prohibited & if found action may be referred to the appropriate authority for prosecution as per relevant IT Act with forfeiture of earnest money forthwith.
- u) The Earnest Money may be forfeited if;
  - i) If the Bidder withdraws the Bid during the period of Bid validity.

- ii) In case of successful Bidder, if the Bidder fails to execute formal agreement within the stipulated time period.
- iii) During scrutiny, if it is come to the notice of tender inviting authority that the credential or any other document which were uploaded & digitally signed by the Bidder are incorrect /manufactured / fabricated.
- v) The successful Bidder shall have to execute Formal Agreement with Managing Director, West Bengal Medical Services Corporation Limited within 7(Seven) days from the issuance of Provisional Work order.
- w) Bank guarantee shall be accepted for the purpose of the security.
- 1. In the event of e-filing, intending bidder may download the tender documents from the website: http://https://wbtenders.gov.in directly with the help of Digital Signature Certificate.NecessaryEarnest Money will be deposited by the bidder electronically online through his net banking enabled bank account, maintained at any nationalized bank by generating NEFT/RTGS challan from the e-tendering portal and also to be documented through e-filing.

As per G.O. No. 1592 – F(Y) dated. 20.03.2014 of the Finance Deptt.of Govt. of West Bengal, in case of e–tendering, EMD/Bid security will have to be submitted as soft copy (scanned copies of the originals) along with the tender for instruments and in case of deposit of money it should compulsorily be deposited on – line by the bidders. The L1 bidder will submit the hard copy of the documents to the tender inviting authority with his acceptance letter of the LOI within specified time as mentioned in the letter of acceptance. Failure to submit the hard copy with the acceptance letter within the time period prescribed for the purpose may be construed as an attempt to disturb the tendering process and dealt with accordingly legally including blacklisting of the bidder.

- 2. Both Technical bid and Financial Bid are to be submitted concurrently duly signed digitallyin the website https://wbtenders.gov.in
- 3. Dully filled in copies of Section II (Forms I to V) in prescribed proforma with proper dated signature in the relevant spaces to be uploaded electronically.

Documents in support of the information furnished in Forms I to V, must be attached/uploaded for evaluation and the file number & page number has to be indicated in the respective column of the Form.

- 4. i) On selection of RTGS/NEFT as the payment mode, the e-Procurement portal will show a prefilled challan having the details to process RTGS/NEFT transaction.
  - ii) The bidder will print the challan and use the pre-filled information to make RTGS/NEFT payment using his Bank account.
  - iii) The EMD of the bidders disqualified at the technical evaluation will be refunded through an automated process to the respective biddres' bank accounts from which they made the payment transaction.
- 5. 4. The Financial Offer of the prospective Tenderer will be considered only if the Tenderer qualifies in the Technical Bid. The decision of the Managing Director, WEST BENGAL MEDICAL SERVICES CORPORATION LIMITED will be final and binding on all concerned and no challenge against such decision will be entertained.
- 6. In case of inadvertent typographical mistake found in the Specific Price Schedule of Rates i.e. Bill of Quantity (BOQ), the same will be treated as to be so corrected as to conform with the prevailing relevant Schedule of Rates and/or Technically Sanctioned Estimate.

- 7. Running payment for work may be made to the executing agency as per availability of fund. The executing agency may not get a running payment unless the gross amount of Running Bill stands at least 20% (Twenty Percent) of the tendered amount. Provisions in Clause(s) 7, 8& 9 contained in W.B. Form No. 2911(ii) so far as they relate to quantum and frequency of payment is to be treated as superseded.
- 8. Bids shall remain valid for a period not less than 120 (one hundred twenty) days after the dead line date for Financial Bid submission.

- 10. Cost of Tender Documents: NIL (As per Notification of the Secretary, Public Works Department, CRC Branch, Government of West Bengal vide No. 199-CRC/2M-10/2012 dated: 21/12/2012 communicated by the Technical Secretary, Public Works Department, Government of West Bengal that the intending tenderers shall not have to pay the cost of tender documents for the purpose of participating in e-tendering.)
- 11. Earnest Money: The amount of Earnest Money is to be submitted Online through his net banking enabled bank account, maintained at any nationalized bank by generating NEFT/RTGS challan from the e-tendering portal and also to be documented through e-filing. The process of deposit of earnest money through offline instruments like Bank Draft, Pay Order etc. will be stopped for e-tender procurement of this office w.e.f. 01.09.2016.

Once the financial bid evaluation is electronically processed in the e-Procurement portal, EMD of the technically qualified bidders other than that of L1 and L2 bidders will be refunded through an automated process to the respective bidders' bank accounts from which they made the payment transaction. If the L1 bidder accepts the LOI and the same is processed electronically in the e-Procurement portal, EMD of the L2 bidder will be refunded through an automated process to his bank account from which he made the payment transaction.

The earnest money of the successful bidder (being converted to security deposit) deposited, will remain under the custody of the department till satisfactory completion of the work in full including extended quantity if ordered for. Besides this, necessary percentages shall be deducted from the progressive bids so as to make it 10% (Ten percent) of the value of work billed.

12. The Bidder, at his own responsibility and risk is encouraged to visit and examine the site of works and its surroundings and obtain all information that may be necessary for preparing the Bid and entering into a contract for the work as mentioned in the Notice Inviting Tender, before submitting the offer with full satisfaction. The cost of visiting the site shall be at his own expense.

- 13. The intending Bidders should clearly understand that whatever may be the outcome of the present invitation of Bids, no cost of Bidding shall be reimbursable by the Department. The Managing Director, WEST BENGAL MEDICAL SERVICES CORPORATION LIMITED reserves the right to reject any or all the application(s) for purchasing Bid Documents and/or to accept or reject any or all the offer(s) without assigning any reason whatsoever and is not liable for any cost that might have been incurred by any Tenderer at the stage of Bidding.
- 14. The intending bidders are required to quote the rate online only. No offline tender will be entertained.
- 15. If more than one Bidder quoted same rate and which are found lowest at the time of opening, such similar multiple rates will not be entertained / accepted. Lowest offer will be ascertained by sealed bid amongst the lowest bidders.
- 16. Contractor shall have to comply with the provisions of (a) the contract labour (Regulation Abolition) Act. 1970 (b) Apprentice Act. 1961 and (c) minimum wages Act. 1948 and any other notification thereof or any other laws relating thereto and the rules made and order issued there under from time to time.
- 17. During the scrutiny, if it comes to the notice of the tender inviting authority that the credential(s) and/or any other paper(s) of any bidder is / are incorrect/ manufactured/fabricated, that bidder(s) will not be allowed to participate in the tender and that application will be rejected outright.
- 18. The Managing Director, WBSMCL reserves the right to cancel the N.I.T. or issue corrigendum notices to the NIT due to unavoidable circumstances and no claim in this respect will be entertained.
- 19. List of "Technically Qualified Bidders" will be published in the web portal only. Financial Bid will be opened within a short period after such publication. Therefore, Bidders are requested to view the tender status on a regular basis.
- 20. In case of any objection regarding prequalifying an Agency, that should be lodged to the ManagingDirector, WEST BENGAL MEDICAL SERVICES CORPORATION LIMITED within 1(one) day from the date of publication of the list of qualified agencies and beyond that time schedule no objection will be entertained.
- 21. Before issuance of the work order, the tender inviting authority may verify the credential(s) and/or other document(s) of the lowest tenderer, if found necessary. After verification, if it is found that the document(s) submitted by the lowest tenderer is/are either manufactured or false, the work order will not be issued in favour of the said Tenderer.
- 22. If any discrepancy arises between two similar clauses on different notifications, the clause as stated in later notification will supersede former one in following sequence;
  - a) Notice Inviting Tender
  - b) Special Terms and Conditions
  - c) Financial Bid
  - d) Schedule of Works

All works covered in the clause appearing hereinafter shall be deemed to form a part of the appropriate item or items of works appearing in the work schedule whether specifically

mentioned in any clause or not and the rates quoted shall include all such works unless it is otherwise mentioned that extra payment will be made for particular works.

- 23. Schedule of Rates applicable for execution of the work :Latest P.W.D.'s Schedule of Rates for Buildings Works, (Volume- I) withall latest Addenda & Corrigenda.
- 24. As per memorandum no. 4608-F(Y) dated.18.07.2018 of Finance Department Govt. of West Bengal, the successful bidder will have to submit Additional Performance Security @10% of the tendered amount, if the accepted bid value is 80% or less of the estimated amount put to tender. The Additional Performance Security shall be submitted in the form of Bank Guarantee from any Scheduled Bank before issuance of the Work Order. If the bidder fails to submit the Additional Performance Security within seven working days from the date of issuance of Letter of Acceptance, his Earnest Money will be forfeited and other necessary actions as per NIT like blacklisting of the contractor, etc, may be taken. The Bank Guarantee shall have to be valid upto end of the Contract Period and shall be renewed accordingly, if required. The Bank Guarantee shall be returned after completion of the contract period. If the bidder fails to complete the work successfully, the Additional Performance Security shall be forfeited at any time during the pendency of the contract period after serving proper notice to the contractor. Necessary provisions regarding deduction of security deposit from the progressive bills of the contractor as per relevant clauses of the contract shall in no way be altered/affected byprovision of this Additional Performance Security.

Intending tenderers are required to submit online attested/self-attested photocopies of valid enlistment renewal certificate, valid partnership deed (in case of partnership firm), current Professional Tax Deposit Challan / Professional Tax Clearance Certificate, PAN Card, Trade License from the respective Municipality, Panchayet etc. (in case of S & P Contractors only), [Non statutory documents]

In case of Registered Unemployed Engineers' Co-operative Societies and Registered Labour Cooperative Societies, attested photocopies of <u>documents of credentials showing satisfactory completion of a single work in any Government Department commencing on or after 01.04.2009 of value not less than 40% of the Estimated Cost of the work applied for, 'Certificate of Registration' from the respective Assistant Registrar of Co-operative Societies, Professional Tax Deposit Challan / Professional Tax Clearance Certificate, PAN Card, must be submitted online. Payment certificates in lieu of credentials will not be accepted. [Non statutory documents]</u>

The intending tenderer is required to quote the rate in figures as well as in words as **percentageabove** / **below than or at par** with the relevant price schedule of rates as per the FORM-V in Section-II

## Conditional / incomplete quotation will not be entertained.

Issuance of work order as well as payment will depend on availability of fund and no claim whatsoever will be entertained for delay of Issuance of work order as well as payment, if any. Intending tenderers may consider this criterion while quoting their rates.

If any tenderer withdraws his offer before acceptance or refuse within a reasonable time without giving any satisfactory explanation for such withdrawals, he shall be disqualified from submitting tender to WEST BENGAL MEDICAL SERVICES CORPORATION LIMITED for a minimum period of 1(one) year.

Tax and other deductions shall be made as below:

- i) GST will be deducted as applicable.
- ii) Cess @ 1% (One Percent) of the cost of construction works will be deducted from the bills of the contractors on all contracts awarded on or after 01.11.2006 in pursuance with G.O. No. 599A/4M- 28/06 dated 27.09.2006.
- iii) 2% (Two percent) Income Tax of the cost of construction work will be deducted from the bill.

- iv) Security Money deposit @ 8% (Eight Percent) will be deducted from the progressive bills in addition to the earnest money to make a total deposit of 10%(Ten Percent) of the value of work executed.
- Modification in the West Bengal Form No.: 2911/2911(ii)/2911(ii)Clause 17 of CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT of the Printed Tender Form shall be substituted by the following vide Govt. Notification No 5784-PW/PW/L&A/2M-175/2017 dated 12.09.2017:

'Clause 17 - If the contractor or his workmen or servants or authorized representatives shall break, deface, injure, or destroy any part of building, in which they may be working, or any building, road, road-curbs, fence, enclosure, water pipes, cables, drains, electric or telephone posts or wires, trees, grass or grassland or cultivated ground contiguous to the premises, on which the work or any part of it is being executed, or if any damage shall happen to the work from any cause whatsoever or any imperfection become apparent in it at any time whether during its execution or within a period of three months or one year or three years or five years, as the case may be (depending upon the nature of the work as described in the explanation appended hereto) hereinafter referred to as the Defect Liability Period, from the actual date of completion of work as per completion certificate issued by the Engineer-in-Charge, the contractor shall make the same good at his own expense, or in default, the Engineer-in-Charge may cause the same to be made good by other workmen and deduct the expense (of which the certificate of the Engineer-in-Charge shall be final and binding on all concerned) from any sums, whether under this contract or otherwise, that may be then, or at any time thereafter become due to the contractor from the Government or from his security deposit, either full, or of a sufficient portion thereof and if the cost, in the opinion of the Engineer-in-Charge (which opinion shall be final and conclusive against the contractor), of making such damage or imperfection good shall exceed the amount of such security deposit and/or such sums, it shall be lawful for the Government to recover the excess cost from the contractor in accordance with the procedure prescribed by any law for the time being in force.

Provided further that the Engineer-in-Charge shall pass the "Final Bill" and certify thereon, within a period of thirty days with effect from the date of submission of the final bill in acceptable form by the contractor, the amount payable to the contractor under this contract and shall also issue a separate completion certificate mentioning the actual date of completion of the work to the contractor within the said period of thirty days. The certificate of the Engineer-in-Charge whether in respect of the amount payable to the contractor against the "Final Bill" or in respect of completion of work shall be final and conclusive against the contractor . However, the security deposit of the work held with the Government under the provision of clause 1 hereof shall be refundable to the contractor in the manner provided here under:-

- (a) For work with three months Defect Liability Period:
  - i) Full security deposit shall be refunded to the contractor on expiry of three months from the actualdate of completion of the work.
- (b) For work with one year Defect Liability Period:
  - Full security deposit shall be refunded to the contractor on expiry of one year from the actual dateof completion of the work.
- (c) For work with three years Defect Liability Period:
  - i) 30% of the security deposit shall be refunded to the contractor on expiry of two years from the actual date of completion of the work;
  - ii) The balance 70% of the security deposit shall be refunded to the contractor on expiry of threeyears from the actual date of completion of the work;
- (d) For work with five years Defect Liability Period:
  - i) No security deposit shall be refunded to the contractor
  - ii) for 1s t 3 years from the actual date of completion of the work;
  - iii) 30% of the security deposit shall be refunded to the contractor on expiry of four years from theactual date of completion of the work;
  - iv) The balance 70% of the security deposit shall be refunded to the contractor on expiry of fiveyears from the actual date of completion of the work;

## Explanation:

The word 'work' means and includes building work, road work, drain work, sanitary and plumbing work and/or any other work contemplated within the scope and ambit of this contract. For

- The work of patch repair or patch maintenance in nature or a combination thereof, the Defect Liability Period of the work shall be three months from the actual date of completion of the work.
- ii) Thorough Bituminous Surfacing work with bituminous thickness less than 40 mm, Repair & Rehabilitation of anyroad / bridge / culvert / building / Sanitary & Plumbing work, the Defect Liability Period of the work shall be oneyear from the actual date of completion of the work;
- iii) Extension of building / bridge / culvert, Construction of new flexible pavement up to bituminous level which hasbeen designed for a period of 3 years or more, Widening and strengthening of flexible pavement designed for aperiod of 3 years or more, Improvement of riding quality / Strengthening of flexible pavement designed for aperiod of 3 years or more; Providing only mastic asphalt layer over existing bituminous surface withoutproviding bituminous profile corrective course / bituminous base course, the Defect Liability Period of the work shall be three years from the actual date of completion of the work;
- iv) Construction of new building / new bridge / new culvert, Reconstruction of building / bridge / culvert includingconstruction of approach roads for bridge / culvert, Construction of rigid pavement, Reconstruction of rigidpavement, Construction of new flexible pavement covered by mastic work which has been designed for a periodof 5 years or more, Widening and strengthening of flexible pavement covered by mastic work which has beendesigned for a period of 5 years or more, Improvement of riding quality / Strengthening of flexible pavementcovered by mastic work which has been designed for a period of 5 years or more, the Defect Liability Period ofthe work shall be five years from the actual date of completion of the work;

Successful Tenderers will be required to obtain valid Registration Certificate &Labour License from respective Regional Labour Offices where construction work by them are proposed to be carried outas per Clauses u/s 7 of West Bengal Building & other Construction Works' Act, 1996 and u/s 12 of Contract Labour Act.

Power of Attorney holders are not allowed to sign Tender Documents unless otherwise approved bythe Government.

Clause-25 of the conditions of contract of the West Bengal Form No. 2911/2911(ii) may be treated to be omitted and there is no provision for arbitration for resolution of disputes that may arise out of the contracts to be entered into by the Department with the contractors for the purpose of carryingout execution of public works as per G.O No. 558/SPW dated 13-12-2011 of P.W.D.

## Successful tenderers will be required to observe the following conditions strictly:

- a. Employees' Provident Fund and Miscellaneous Provisions Act, 1952 and Employees StateInsuranceAct, 1948 should be strictly adhered to wherever such Acts become applicable.
- b. Minimum wages to the workers shall be paid according to the rates notified and/or revised by theState Government from time to time under the Minimum Wages Act, 1948 in respect ofscheduled employments, within the specified time as per law. Payment of bonus, whereverapplicable, has to be made.
- c. Adequate safety and welfare measures must be provided as per the provisions of the Building andother Construction Workers' (Regulation of Employment & Conditions of Service) Act, 1996 readwith West Bengal Building and Other Construction Workers (Regulation of Employment andConditions of Service) Rules, 2004.

d. All liabilities arising out of engagement of workers are duly met before submission of bills forpayment.

If there is any violation of any or all the relevant above criterion during execution of the job, it willrender the concerned agencies ineligible for the work then and there or at any subsequent stage as may be found convenient.

## **INSTRUCTION TO BIDDERS**

#### SECTION - I

## 1. General guidance for e-Tendering

Instructions/Guidelines for tenders for electronic submission of the tenders online have beenannexed for assisting the contractors to participate in e-Tendering.

## 1. Registration of Contractor

Any contractor willing to take part in the process of e-Tendering will have to be enrolled &registered with the Government e-Procurement system, through logging on to https://wbtenders.gov.in the contractor is to clickon the link for e-Tendering site as given on the web portal.

## 2. Digital Signature certificate (DSC)

Each contractor is required to obtain a class-I, class-II or Class-III Digital SignatureCertificate(DSC) for submission of tenders, from the approved service provider of the NationalInformation's Centre(NIC) on payment of requisite amount details are available at the Website stated in Clause-2 of Guideline to Bidder DSC is given as a USB e- Token.

3. The contractor can search & download NIT & Tender Documents electronically from computer once he logs on to the website mentioned in Clause 2 using the Digital Signature Certificate. This is the only mode of collection of Tender Documents.

## 4. Participation in more than one work

A prospective bidder shall be allowed to participate in the job either in the capacity ofindividual or as a partner of a firm. If found to have applied severally in a single job all hisapplications will be rejected for that job.

## 5. Submission of Tenders

- (vi) IftheContractorbeingaCompanypassaresolutionorthecourtdeliversanorder ofjudgementthat theCompanyshallbewoundup,or ifa receiveroramanageron behalfofacreditorbeappointed, orifacircumstancearise whichentitletheCourt orthecreditortoappointareceiveroramanagerorwhichentitlethecourtto issue awindingup order;
- (vii) If the Contractor shall suffer an execution or derbeing levied on his/hergoods and allows it to be continued for a period of 21 days;
- (viii) If the Contractor assigns without prior written approval of the Tender Accepting

Authority,transfers,sublets(engagementof labouron pieceworkbasisor of labourwithmaterialsnot tobeincorporatedinthework, shallnotbedeemedtobe subletting)orotherwise partswithorattemptstoassign,transfer,subletor otherwise partswiththeentireworkoranyportion thereofwithoutprior written approvalof the Engineer-in-charge;

- (ix) AND THEREFORE, the Contractor hasmadehimself/herselfliable foractionunder anyofthecases aforesaid, the Engineer-in-charge on behalf of the Government with the prior approval of Tender Accepting Authority, shall have the power sto adopt any of the Government:-
  - (a) Todeterminethecontractasaforesaid, of which rescission notice in writing andcoststoberecoveredforworkssinceexecutedsubjecttoaminimumof theamountofEarnestMoneydeposited bytheContractorunderthehand Engineer-in-charge, shall conclusive evidence. be the Upon suchdetermination, the Earnest Money Deposit, Security Deposital ready recovered forexecutedworksandperformanceguarantee, if anyunderthecontractshall beliabletobeforfeited and shall be absolutely at the disposal of the Government.
  - (b) AftergivingnoticetotheContractortomeasure uptheworkexecuted andto takesuchwholeorthebalanceorpartthereof,asshallbeun-executed outof his/her hands, andtogiveittoanotherContractor tocomplete thebalance work. TheContractor, whosecontract isdetermined orrescindedasabove, shallnotbeallowedtoparticipateinthetenderingprocessforthebalance work.
  - (c) To employ labour paid by the implementing Department, and to supply materials, to carry out the worksor any part of the work, debarring the contractoranddebitingthecostoflabourandpriceofmaterials(oftheamountof whichcostandpricedeterminedbycertificateoftheEngineer-in-Chargeshall befinalandconclusiveagainstthecontractor)andcreditinghim/herwiththe valueoftheworkdone, in all respects in the same manner and at the same rates as if it had been carried out by the contractor under the terms of his/hercontract; the certificate of the Executive Engineer as to the value of the workdone shall be final and conclusive against the contractor.

Contractors remains liable to pay compensation if actionnottaken under Clause3 IntheeventofabovecoursebeingadoptedbytheEngineer-in-charge,theContractor shallhavenoclaimofcompensation foranylosssustainedbyhim/herbyreasonof his/herhavingpurchasedorprocuredanymaterialorenteredintoanyengagement or made any advances on any account or with a view to execute the work or the performance of the contract. In case, action is taken under any of the provisions aforesaid,thecontractor shallnotbeentitledtorecoverorbepaidanysumforanywork thereofactually performed under thiscontract,unlessanduntiltheEngineer-in-charge hascertifiedinwritingthattheperformance ofsuchworkandvaluepayable inrespect thereof, and he/sheshallonly be entitled to be paidthe value socertified.

**Clause3B.**Incaseacontinuing workcannotbecompletedduetoreasonsbeyond controlofthecontractor, likeForceMajeureenumerated laterunderClause 5,the contractmaybeterminatedasstatedinclause3AabovebytheEngineer-in-Charge withtheconsent of the contractorand approvaloftheTenderAcceptingAuthority.

**Clause4.**In cases in which any of the powers conferred upon the Engineer-in-ChargeunderClause3hereofshall havebecomeexercisableandthesamehadnot

Powertotake possessionofor requireremoval oforsell Contractor's plant been previously exercised, non-exercising thereof shall not constitute as a waiver of any of conditionshereto, and such powers shall, not with standing be exercisable in the eventofany for which by any case of default by the contractor, clause or clauseshereof,he/sheis declaredliableto paycompensationamounting to wholeof his/her and the liability of the contractor for deposit, past future compensationshallremainunaffected.IntheeventoftheEngineer-in-Chargeputting inforce powersunderix(a)or(c)vestedwithhim/herunderthepreceding either ofthe clause, he/shemayifhe/shesodesires, takepossession of all or any tools&plant, materials and thesite thereof, stores. upon the work, or or belonging contractor, or procured by him/herandintended to be used for execution of the work, oranypartthereof, paying or allowing for the same in account at the contract rates or in case of these being applicable, current marketratestobecertifiedbythe Engineer-in-Chargewhosecertificate thereof, shall be final and binding. Otherwise, the Engineer-in-Chargemaydeliver notice inwriting to the contractor or his/herclerk, foremanor otherauthorizedagent, requiring him/hertoremove such tools &plant. materials or stores from the premises within a time to be specified in such notice; and in theeventofthecontractor failingtocomplywithanysuchrequisition, the Engineer-in-Chargemayremovethematthecontractor's expense or sale them by public auction ofthecontractorandathis/herrisk,inallrespects, orprivatesaleonaccount andthe certificateoftheEngineer-in-Chargeas to the expense of any such removal, and the amount of any such sale shall be finalandconclusive of theproceeds and expense against the contractor.

Clause 5. The time allowed for execution of a work as specified in the 'Schedule of  $Work' or in the extended time in accordance with the terms and conditions shall be {\tt restricted}. The term {\tt restricted} is a substitution of {\tt restricted} in {\tt restric$ theessenceofthecontract. Execution of workshall commence from such time period asmentioned inthesaidschedule, or from the date of handing over of the site to the contractor whicheveris later. If the contractor commits default in commencing executionof the work as aforesaidwithin thirty days, without justifiablereasons includedunderForce Majeure orothersuch reasonsbeyondthe control of the contractor, in which case to be reported within seven days bv the contractor, considered validand cogent by the Engineer-in-Charge, the Engineer-in-Charge shall afterpassingofthirtydaysfromthedateofscheduledcommencement ofworkasper work order, with the prior approval of the Tender Accepting Authority. without prejudicetoanyotherrighttoremedyayailableinlaw,beatlibertytoapplyclause2 and subsequently clause 3 of the tender document.

soon as possible after the contract is executed, signed and agreed, the contractorshall submit a Time and ProgressChart'for each broad activity (Milestone)andgetitapprovedbytheEngineer-in-Charge. Thechartshallbe prepared direct relation to the times lated in the Notice Inviting Tenderdocument, for completion ofitemsorgroupofitemsofthe work.Itshallindicate theforecastofthedatesofcommencement andcompletionofvarioustradesof sectionsofthework. This may beamended, as necessary, by an agreement between the Engineer-in-Chargeandthecontractorwithinthe limitationsof timeimposedintheNITdocument.Further,toensuregoodprogressduring execution of work, the contractors hall in all cases, in which the time allowed for any work month(save and exceptfor special iobs exceedsone for whicha separateprogrammehasbeenagreedupon)tocompletetheworkasperdefined 'Milestones' giveninsuch'ScheduleofWork'definedclearlyintheNITitselfinto various'Identifiableandquantifiableconstructionrelatedstages'relatedwith thetypeandnature of work, and that the 'total time allowed for completion οf work'istobebrokenupagainstachievement ofthosestages duringthe construction worktoensureaperiodicmonitoring /progressof ofprogressand enablethecontractorandtheEngineer-in-Charge totakecorrectivemeasures fromtimetotime.

#### **5.2**Ifthework(s)bedelayedby:

Forcemajeure, due towar, internalemergency and other conditions such as abnormally bad weather, flood, cyclone natural calamity or serious loss or damagebyfireorcivilcommotion. strikeorlockoutaffecting procurement of constructionmaterialsoranyofthetradesemployed in the work.or anvother causewhichintheabsolutediscretionoftheEngineer-in-Chargeisbevondthe contractor's control, the nupon happening of any such event causing delay, the

contractorshallimmediatelygivenoticeinwritingtotheEngineer-in-Chargebut shallneverthelessuseconstantlyhis/herbestendeavorstopreventormake good the delay and shall do all that may be reasonably required to the satisfactionoftheEngineer-in-Chargetoproceedwith the works.

- **5.3**Requestforreschedulingof'Milestones'ofvariousactivitiesandextensionof time, to be eligible for consideration, shall be made by the contractor in writing within fourteen days of the happening of the event causing delay in the prescribed form. The contractor also, if practicable, indicate in such a request the period for which extension is desired.
- **5.4**Ifanysuchcasethe Engineer-in-Charge, withtheapprovalofTender Accepting Authority,maygiveafairandreasonableextensionoftimeandreschedule the activitywise'Milestones' forcompletion ofthework.Suchextensionshallbe communicatedtothecontractorbytheEngineer-in-Chargewiththeapprovalof TenderAcceptingAuthorityinwritingwithinmaximum1(one) monthofthe dateofreceiptofsuchrequest.

FinalCertificate

Clause6. On completion work, the contractors hall be furnished with a certificate the Engineer-in-Charge of such completion, but no such certificates hall be given, nor shallthe work be considered to be completeduntil andunless the contractor shall have removedfromthework premises on which the work is executed, all scaffolding, surplusmaterialsandrubbish, and cleaned off the dirt from wood works, doors, windows, floors, or otherparts of any building, upon or about which the work executed, or of which he may have had possession for the purpose of the execution thereof, noruntiltheworkshall have been measured by the Engineer-in-charge measurementsshall be binding and conclusive against the contractor. If the contractorshallfailtocomplywith therequirements of this clause as to removalofscaffolding, surplus materials and rubbishandcleaningoffdirtonorbeforethedatefixedfor completion of work, the Engineer-in-charge may at the expense of the contractor removesuchscaffolding, andrubbish, anddisposeofthesameas surplusmaterials he/shethinksfit,andcleanoffsuchdirtasaforesaid;andthecontractorshallforthwith be bound to respect paytheamountofallexpensesoincurred, and shall have no claimin of any scaffolding surplusmaterialsasaforesaid, except for any sum actually realized by the sale thereof.

Paymenton inter-mediate certificatesto beregarded asadvances

Clause7. Norunning account bill payments hall be normally made for worksless than 30 (Thirty) ofTenderedValueoruptoRs25.00lakh,whichever isless, tillafter the percent wholeoftheworkshallhavebeencompletedandcertificateofcompletiongiven.For worksoftenderedvalueaboveRs25.00lakh,forrunningaccountbill payment,the contractorshall onsubmitting abillofatleastRs25.00lakhtherefor, be entitled to receive a payment proportionate to the part thereof, approved and passed by the Engineer-incharge, whose certificate of such approval and passing of the sum so payableshallbefinalandconclusiveagainstthecontractor.Butallsuchintermediate payments shallberegardedaspaymentsbywayofadvanceagainstthefinalmeasured bill paymentonlyandnotaspaymentsforworkactuallydoneandcompleted,andshall not preclude the bad, un sound, and imperfector unskill ful work which is to be removedandtakenawayandreconstructed,orre-erectedortobeconsideredasanadmissionof thedueperformanceofthecontract, or any part thereof, in any respect, or the accruing ofanyclaim, norshallit conclude, determine or affect in anyway the powers of theEngineer-incharge undertheseconditionsoranyofthemastothefinalsettlementand adjustment of the accounts or otherwise or in any other way vary or affect the contract. Thefinalbillshallbesubmittedbythecontractorwithin onemonthofthedatefixedfor completionofthework, otherwise the Engineer-in-charge's certificate of the measurement and of the total amount payable for the work accordingly shall be final and binding on all parties.

Billsto be submitted monthly

Clause8. Works billshall besubmitted by the contractor each month, afterfulfilling above clause, or beforethe date fixed bv the Engineer-in-charge, for executedduringtheprevious month, andtheEngineer-in-charge shalltakeorcause taketherequisitemeasurementforthepurposeofhavingthesameverified, and the claim asfarasadmissible adjusted, if possible, before the expiry offourteen days from the presentationofthe bill. Ifthecontractor doesnotsubmit thebillwithinthetimefixedas aforesaid, the Engineer-in-charge may depute a Junior Engineer to measure up the said

work in presence of the contractor, whose counter signature in the measurement book will be sufficient warrant; and the Engineer-in-charge may prepare a bill from such list which shall be binding on the contractor in all respects.

Within 10(Ten)daysofcompletion ofwork, the contractors hall give notice of such completion to the Engineer-in-charge and within 14(Fourteen) daysofrece ip to fsuch notice, the Engineer-in-charge shall inspect the work, and if there is no defect in the work, he/she shall furnish to the contractor a final certificate of completion. Otherwise, a provisional certificate of physical completion indicating defects (a) to be rectified by the Contractor and/or(b) for which payment will be made a treduced rates, shall be is sued. Such reduced rate is to be imposed with the approval of Superintending Engineer concerned.

Clause 8A. When annual repair and maintenance work is carried out, the splashes and droppings fromwhitewashing, colourwashing, painting etc., onwalls, floors, windows shallberemovedandthesurfacecleanedsimultaneously withthecompletionofthese itemsofworkintheindividualrooms, quartersorpremisesetc.wheretheworkisdone withoutwaitingfortheactualcompletionofalltheotheritemsofworkinthecontract. In case, the of this clause, the Engineer-incontractor fails to comply with the requirements Chargeshall have the right to get this work done at the cost of the contractoreitherDepartmentally orthroughanyothercontractor.Beforetakingsuch action, the Engineer-in-Chargeshall givetendays notice in writing to the contractor.

Clause 8B. The Contractors hall submit completion Plan/Drawing as required in the `General Specification` for Civilas well as Electrical Works as applicable within 30 days of completion of the work.

**Clause9.**TheContractor shallsubmit allbillsinprintedforms, as per format prescribed by Government of West Bengal, intheofficeoftheEngineer- in-Charge,andthecharges inthebillsshallalwaysbeenteredattheratesspecifiedin tenderorincaseofanyextraworkorderedinpursuanceoftheseconditions,andnot mentionedorprovidedforinthetenderatratesthereinafterprovidedforsuchwork.

Payments of contractor's billstoBanks

**Clause9A**(1)Paymentsduetothecontractormay,ifsodesiredbyhim/herbemade tohisbankthroughe-Pradan,detailsof whichhastobedirectlyfurnishedtotheEngineer-incharge.

While the onlinereceipt given by such Banks shall constitute a full and sufficient discharge/acquittancefor the payment, the contractor should wherever possible presenthis/herbillsdulyreceiptedanddischargedthroughhis/herBanker/s.

(2) Inthecaseof bills, which the contractor presents for payment direct, and which are not endorsed in favour of the Bank, while efforts will be made to secure payment to the financing Bank, payments made to the contractor should be accepted as full acquittances of a rashe Government is concerned. As a part of the arrangement, the financing Bankshould give the Government a letter to this effect.

Note1. The procedure will not affect theusual rights of the Government to deductfrom contractor's bill, (whether endorsed in favour of a Bankornot) any sum due to Government of account of penalties, over-payments etc., on this or any other contract with the Governor of the State of West Bengal.

Anysuchmaterial unusedandinperfectlygoodconditionatthetimeofthecompletionor determinationof thecontractshallbereturnedtotheEngineer-in-charge's store, if by anotice in writing underhis/herhand, he/she shallso require; butthecontractors hall not been titled to return materialunless with such consent, andshallhave noclaimfor sosuppliedtohim/herasaforesaidbeing compensationonaccountofanysuchmaterial unusedbyhim, orfor anywastageordamagetoany suchmaterial.

'Clause 17 - If the contractor or his workmen or servants or authorized representatives shall break, deface, injure, or destroy any part of building, in which they may be working, or any building, road, road-curbs, fence, enclosure, water pipes, cables, drains, electric or telephone posts or wires, trees, grass or grassland or cultivated ground contiguous to the premises, on which the work or any part of it is being executed, or if any damage shall happen to the work from any cause whatsoever or any imperfection become apparent in it at any time whether during its execution or within a period of three months or one year or three years or five years, as the case may be (depending upon the nature of the work as described in the explanation appended hereto) hereinafter referred to as the Defect Liability Period, from the actual date of completion of work as per completion certificate issued by the Engineer-in-Charge, the contractor shall make the same good at his own expense, or in default, the Engineerin-Charge may cause the same to be made good by other workmen and deduct the expense (of which the certificate of the Engineer-in-Charge shall be final and binding on all concerned) from any sums, whether under this contract or otherwise, that may be then, or at any time thereafter become due to the contractor from the Government or from his security deposit, either full, or of a sufficient portion thereof and if the cost, in the opinion of the Engineer-in-Charge (which opinion shall be final and conclusive against the contractor), of making such damage or imperfection good shall exceed the amount of such security deposit and/or such sums, it shall be lawful for the Government to recover the excess cost from the contractor in accordance with the procedure prescribed by any law for the time being in force.-

Provided further that the Engineer-in-Charge shall pass the "Final Bill" and certify thereon, within a period of thirty days with effect from the date of submission of the final bill in acceptable form by the contractor, the amount payable to the contractor under this contract and shall also issue a separate completion certificate mentioning the actual date of completion of the work to the contractor within the said period of thirty days. The certificate of the Engineer-in-Charge whether in respect of the amount payable to the contractor against the "Final Bill" or in respect of completion of work shall be final and conclusive against the contractor. However, the security deposit of the work held with the Government under the provision of clause 1 hereof shall be refundable to the contractor in the manner provided here under:-

- (a) For work with three months Defect Liability Period:
  - ii) Full security deposit shall be refunded to the contractor on expiry of three months from the actualdate of completion of the work.
- (b) For work with one year Defect Liability Period:
  - ii) Full security deposit shall be refunded to the contractor on expiry of one year from the actual dateof completion of the work.
- (c) For work with three years Defect Liability Period:
  - iii) 30% of the security deposit shall be refunded to the contractor on expiry of two years from the actual date of completion of the work;
  - iv) The balance 70% of the security deposit shall be refunded to the contractor on expiry of threeyears from the actual date of completion of the work;
- (d) For work with five years Defect Liability Period:
  - v) No security deposit shall be refunded to the contractor
  - vi) for 1s t 3 years from the actual date of completion of the work;
  - vii) 30% of the security deposit shall be refunded to the contractor on expiry of four years from theactual date of completion of the work;
  - viii) The balance 70% of the security deposit shall be refunded to the contractor on expiry of fiveyears from the actual date of completion of the work;

## Explanation:

The word 'work' means and includes building work, road work, drain work, sanitary and plumbing work and/or any other work contemplated within the scope and ambit of this contract. For

- v) The work of patch repair or patch maintenance in nature or a combination thereof, the Defect Liability Period of the work shall be three months from the actual date of completion of the work.
- vi) Thorough Bituminous Surfacing work with bituminous thickness less than 40 mm, Repair & Rehabilitation of anyroad / bridge / culvert / building / Sanitary & Plumbing work, the Defect Liability Period of the work shall be oneyear from the actual date of completion of the work;
- vii) Extension of building / bridge / culvert, Construction of new flexible pavement up to bituminous level which hasbeen designed for a period of 3 years or more, Widening and strengthening of flexible pavement designed for aperiod of 3 years or more, Improvement of riding quality / Strengthening of flexible pavement designed for aperiod of 3 years or more; Providing only mastic asphalt layer over existing bituminous surface withoutproviding bituminous profile corrective course / bituminous base course, the Defect Liability Period of the work shall be three years from the actual date of completion of the work;
- viii) Construction of new building / new bridge / new culvert, Reconstruction of building / bridge / culvert includingconstruction of approach roads for bridge / culvert, Construction of rigid pavement, Reconstruction of rigidpavement, Construction of new flexible pavement covered by mastic work which has been designed for a periodof 5 years or more, Widening and strengthening of flexible

pavement covered by mastic work which has beendesigned for a period of 5 years or more, Improvement of riding quality / Strengthening of flexible pavementcovered by mastic work which has been designed for a period of 5 years or more, the Defect Liability Period of the work shall be five years from the actual date of completion of the work;

Successful Tenderers will be required to obtain valid Registration Certificate &Labour License from respective Regional Labour Offices where construction work by them are proposed to be carried out as per Clauses u/s 7 of West Bengal Building & other Construction Works' Act, 1996 and u/s 12 of Contract Labour Act. Power of Attorney holders are not allowed to sign Tender Documents unless otherwise approved by the Government.

Clause 17A. The Contractorshall also supply without charge the requisite number of persons with the means and materials necessary for the purpose of setting outworks, and counting, weighing, assisting in the joint measurement or examination at any time and from time to time of the work or materials. Failing his/herso doing the same may be provided by the Engineer-in-Charge at the expense of the Contractor and the expenses may be deducted from any money due to the contractor under the contract or from his/her Security Depositor the proceeds of sales thereofor of a sufficient portion thereof. The Contractor shall also provide all necessary fencing/barricading/providing caution board setc. and light required to protect the public from accident, and shall be bound to be artheexpenses of defence of every suit, action or other proceedings at law that may be brought by any person for in jury sustained owing to neglect of the above precautions and to pay any damage and costs which may be awarded in such suit, actions or proceedings to any such persons or which may with the consent of the Contractor be paid to compromise any claim by any such persons.

Clause 18A. In every case in which by virtue of the provision sunder sub-section (1)of Section 12, of the Workmen's Compensation Act, 1923, the implementing Department is obligedtopaycompensationtoaworkmanemployedbythecontractor,inexecutionof theworks. The implementing Department willrecoverfromtheContractortheamountof compensation sopaid; and without prejudice to the rights of the Department undersubsection(2)ofsection12,ofthesaidAct,implementing Department shallbeatlibertyto recoversuchamountoranypartthereofbydeductingitfromthesecurity deposit orfrom anysumduebyimplementingDepartmenttotheContractorwhetherunderthiscontract orotherwise. The implementing Departments hall notbeboundto contestanyclaimmade againstitundersub-section(1)Section12,ofthesaidAct,exceptonthewrittenrequest ofthecontractoranduponhis/hergivingtotheimplementingDepartmentfullsecurity forallcostsforwhichtheDepartment mightbecomeliableinconsequence ofcontesting suchclaims.

Clause 18B. Failuretofulfill these requirements shall attract penal provisions of the contract, arising out of the resultant non-implementation of such provisions.

Thelawsaforesaidshallbedeemedtobeapartofthiscontract and any breachthereof shallbedeemedto beabreachof thiscontract.

The contractors hall ensure that no amount by way of commission or otherwise is deducted or recovered by the Dafadar from the wage of workers.

Clause 19C. written instruction ordecision. The reupon, the Dispute Redress al Committee shall give its written instruction ordecision within a period of three months from the date of receipt of the Contractor's letter.

If any material remains unused on completion of the work on account of lesser inactualexecutionforreasonsotherthanauthorized useofmaterials changesof specifications and abandon ment of portion of work, a corresponding deduction equivalent tothecostofunusedmaterialsasdeterminedbytheEngineer-in-Chargeshallbemade and the material returned to the contractor. Although the materials are hypothecated Institute, the contractor undertakes theresponsibilityfortheirproperwatch, safecustody andprotection againstallrisks. Thematerials shall not be removed from site of work withouttheconsentoftheEngineer-in-Chargeinwriting.

The contractors hall be responsible for rectifying defects noticed within Defect Liability Period from the date of completion of the work and the portion of the security deposit relating toworks hall be refunded after the expiry of Defect Liability Period.

**Clause33.**Thecontractorshallprovideallnecessarysuperintendenceduringexecution of the work and as long thereafteras may be necessaryfor properfulfilling of the obligations under the contract.

The contractors hall immediately after receiving letter of acceptance of the tender and beforecommencement ofthework, intimate in writing to the Engineer-in-Charge, the experience, age, address (es) and other particulars along name(s), qualifications, with certificates, of the principal technical representative to be incharge of the work and other representative to be incharged from the principal technical representative to the principal techntechnicalrepresentative(s) who will be supervising the work. The Engineer-in-Chargeshall within3daysofreceiptofsuchcommunication intimateinwritinghis/herapprovalor otherwiseofsuchrepresentative(s)tothecontractor. Any such approval may at any time bewithdrawnandincaseofsuchwithdrawal, thecontractor shallappointanothersuch according to the provisions of this clause. Decision of the tender accepting representative authorityshallbefinalandbindingonthecontractor inthisrespect.Suchaprincipal technicalrepresentative shallbeappointedbythecontractorsoonafterreceiptofthe approval from the Engineer-in-Charge and shall be available at site before start of work.

All the provision sapplicable to the principal technical representativewillalsobeapplicableinsuchacasetothecontractororhisresponsible agent.Theprincipaltechnicalrepresentative and/orthecontractorshallonreceiving reasonable Engineer-in-Chargeor his designated representative(s)in notice the chargeoftheworkinwritingorinpersonorotherwise, presenthimself/herself to the Engineer-inand/oratthesiteofwork, as required, to take instructions. Instructionsgiventotheprincipaltechnical representative or the responsible agent deemed to have the same force as if these have beengiventothecontractor. The principaltechnical representative and/orthecontractor or his/herresponsible authorized agentshallbeactuallyavailable atsiteespecially duringimportant stagesofexecution work, during recording of measurement of works and whenever so required by the Engineer-inby a notice as aforesaid and shall also note down instructions conveyedbytheEngineer-in-Chargeorhis/herdesignatedrepresentativeinthesiteorder

Contractors Superintendence, Supervision, TechnicalStaff& Employees  $book and \\ shall affix his signature into ken of noting down the instructions and into ken of acceptance of measurements.$ 

Ifthe Engineer-in-Charge, whose decision in this respect is final and binding on the contractor, is convinced that no such technical representative(s) is/are effectively appointedoris/areeffectivelyattendingorfulfillingtheprovision ofthisclause, are covery (nonrefundable) shallbeeffectedfromthecontractorasspecifiedinScheduleandthe decisionoftheEngineer-in-Charge asrecordedinthesiteorderbookandmeasurement recordedchecked/testcheckedinMeasurement Booksshallbefinalandbindingonthe contractor. Furtherifthecontractor failstoappointasuitable technicalrepresentative and/orothertechnicalrepresentative(s) andifsuchappointedpersonsarenoteffectively presentorareabsentbymorethantwodayswithoutdulyapproved ordonot substitute dischargetheirresponsibilitiessatisfactorily, the Engineer-in-Chargeshall havefull powers tosuspendtheexecution oftheworkuntilsuchdateassuitableothertechnical representative(s)is/areappointedandthecontractorshallbeheldresponsibleforthe contractors hall submit a certificate ofsocausedtothework.The employmentofthe technicalrepresentative(s) alongwitheveryrunningaccountbill/finalbillandshall produceevidenceifatanytimesorequiredbytheEngineer-in-Charge.

The contractors hall provide and employ on the site only such technical assistants as a sare skilled and experienced in their respective fields and such forement supervisory staff as a recompetent to give proper supervision to the work.

The contractors hall provide and employskilled, semi-skilled and unskilled labourasis necessary for proper and timely execution of the work.

The Engineer-in-Chargeshall beat liberty to object to and require the contractor to remove from the works any person who, in his opinion, mis conducts himself, or is incompetent or negligent in the performance of his duties or whose employment is otherwise considered by the Engineer-in-Charge to be undesirable. Such persons hall not be employed again at works site without the written permission of the Engineer-in-Charge and the persons so removed shall be replaced as soon as possible by competent substitutes.

Ifpursuanttoorunderanylaw,notificationororder,anyRoyalty,Cessorthelike becomespayablebytheimplementingDepartment anddoesnotatanytimebecome payableby thecontractortotheStateGovernment/Localappropriateauthoritiesin respect ofanymaterialusedbythecontractorintheworkstheninsuchacase,itshallbelawful totheDepartment anditwillhavetherightandbeentitledtorecovertheamountpaidin thecircumstancesas aforesaidfromduesofthecontractor.

#### Clause35.

(iii) Thecontractorshall, within a period of 30 days of the imposition taxor levyorcess, give a written notice thereof to the Engineer-in-Charge same is given pursuant to this condition, together with all necessary relating thereto. of any such further that the same is given pursuant to this condition, together with all necessary information relating thereto.

**Clause36.** Without prejudice to any of the rights or remedies under this contract, if the contract or dies, the Engineer-in-charge shall have the option of terminating the contract without compensation to the contract or, but would be liable to clear full dues and claims on work do net o his/her legal successor/s.

Any breach of this condition by the contractor would render him/her liable to be removed from the approved list of contractors of the Department. If however the contractor is registered in any other Department, he/she shall be debarred from tendering in the Department for any breach of this condition.

NOTE: By the term "near relatives" is meant wife, husband, own parents and grandparents, ownchildren andgrandchildren, ownbrothersandsisters, ownuncles, auntsand firstcousinsandtheircorresponding in-laws.

Clause 39.Thework(whether fullyconstructedornot) and all materials, machines, tools and plants, scaffolding, temporary buildings and other connectedtherewithshallbe things attheriskofthecontractor untiltheworkhasbeendeliveredtotheEngineer-in-Charge andacertificatefromhim/hertothateffectobtained. Intheeventoftheworkorany materialsproperlybrought tothesiteforincorporation intheworkbeingdamagedor destrovedinconsequence ofhostilitiesorwarlikeoperation, the contractors hall when ordered(inwriting)bytheEngineer-in-Charge toremoveanydebrisfromthesite,collect and properlystackorremoveinstoreallserviceablematerialssalvagedfromthe damaged withtheprovisionofthis workandshallbepaidatthecontractratesinaccordance agreement fortheworkofclearingthesiteofdebris, stacking orremoval of serviceable material and for reconstruction of all works or dered by the Engineer-in-Charge, such paymentsbeingin additiontocompensationuptothevalueof theworkoriginally executed before not paid for. In caseof being damagedor destroyedand works damagedor destroyedbutnotalreadymeasuredandpaidfor, the compensation shallbeassessedby the Engineer-in-Charge concerned. The contractors hall be paid for the damages/destruction sufferedandfortherestoringthematerialattheratebasedon analysisof rates tenderedfor in accordancewiththe provisionof the contract.The certificateoftheEngineer-in-Chargeregardingthequalityandquantityofmaterialsand thepurposeforwhichtheywere collectedshallbefinalandbinding onallparties to this contract.

Providedalwaysthatnocompensation shallbepayableforanylossinconsequence of hostilitiesorwarlikeoperations againstairraidasaredeemednecessary bytheAirForceOfficersortheEngineer-in- Charge (b)foranymaterialetc. notonthesiteoftheworkorforanytools,plant, machinery,scaffolding,temporarybuildingandotherthingsnotintendedforthework.

In the event of the contractor having to carry out reconstruction as a foresaid, he/she shall be allowed such extension of time for its completion as is considered reasonable by the Engineer-in-charge.

**Clause40.**The contractors hall comply with the provisions of the Apprentices Act, 1961 and the Apprenticeship Rules, 1992 and orders is sued the reunder from time to time. If

he/shefailstodoso,his/herfailurewillbeabreachofthecontract andtheEngineer-in-Chargemay,inhis/herdiscretion, cancelthecontract.Thecontractorshallalsobeliable foranypecuniary liabilityarisingonaccount ofanyviolation byhim/heroftheprovisions ofthesaidAct.

- (4) Anydocumentedunsolicitedattemptbyabidder(APerson/Contractor/Agency
  /JointVenture/Consortium/Corporation participatingintheprocurement
  processand/oraperson/Contractor/Agency/JointVenture/Consortium/
  Corporation having an agreement/contractfor any procurement with the
  department shallbereferredasBidder)undulyinfluencingtheoutcomeofthe
  biddinginhisfavour.
- (5) Refusalorfailuretopostaself-declaration to the effect of any previous debarment imposed by any other department of State Government and/or Central Government.
- (6) Allotheractsthattendtodefeatthepurposeofthecompetitive biddingsuchas lodgingfalsecomplainaboutanyBidder,lodgingfalsecomplain aboutanyOfficer dulyauthorizedbytheDepartment,restraininganyinterestedbiddertoparticipate inthebiddingprocess,etc.
- (7) Assignmentand subcontracting of the contractor any part thereof without prior written approval of the procuring entity.
- (8) Wheneveradversereportsrelatedtoadverse performance, misbehaviour, director indirectinvolvementin threatening, makingfalse complaintsetc. damaging the reputation of the department or anyother type complaint considered fit by the competent authority of the department, are received from more than one Officer or on more than one occasion from individual Officer.
- (9) Refusalorfailuretoposttherequiredperformance security/earnestmoneywithin theprescribedtimewithoutjustifiablecause.
- (10) FailureindeploymentofTechnicalPersonnel, Engineersand/orWorkSupervisor havingrequisitelicense/supervisorcertificateofcompetency asspecifiedinthe contract.
- (11) Refusaltoacceptanawardafterissuanceof"LetterofAcceptance"orenterinto contractwiththeGovernmentwithoutjustifiablecause.
- (12) FailureoftheContractor,duesolelytohisfaultornegligence, tomobilizeandstart workorperformance withinthespecifiedperiodasmentioned inthe"Letterof Acceptance", "Letter of Acceptancecum Work Order", "Work Order", "Notice to Proceed", "Awardof Contract", etc.
- (13) Failure by the Contractor to fully and faithfully comply with its contractual obligations withoutvalidcause, or failure by the Contractor to comply with any written lawful instruction of the Procuring Entity / Authority (the Officer authorized by the Administrative Department, Government of West Bengal for procurement) or its representative (s) pursuant to the implementation of the Contract.
- (14) FortheprocurementofConsultancyService/Contracts, Consultantofhisservicesarisingfromhisfaultornegligence. Anyofthefollowing actsbytheConsultantshallbeconstruedaspoorperformance.
  - (i) Nondeploymentofcompetenttechnicalpersonnel,competentEngineers and/or worksupervisors;
  - (ii) Non-deployment of committed equipment, facilities, support staff and manpower;
  - (iii) Defectivedesignresultinginsubstantialcorrectiveworksindesignand/or construction;

- (iv) Failuretodelivercriticaloutputsduetoconsultant's faultornegligence;
- (v) Specifyingmaterialswhichareinappropriateandsubstandardorwayabove acceptablestandardsleadingtohighprocurementcost;
- (vi) AllowingdefectiveworkmanshiporworksbytheContractorbeing supervisedby theConsultant.
- (15) For the procurementof goods,unsatisfactoryprogressinthe deliveryofthegoodsby themanufacturer, supplier, or distributorarising from his fault or negligence and/or unsatisfactory or inferior quality of goods, vis-à-visas laid down in the contract.
- (16) Willfulordeliberateabandonment ornon-performanceoftheprojectorContractby theContractorresultinginsubstantialbreachthereofwithoutlawfuland/orjust cause.

### **CATEGORYOFOFFENCE:-**

- (A) Firstdegreeofoffence: 1to16oftheaboveClause-41tobeconsideredasFirst degreeofoffence.
- (B) Seconddegreeofoffence:Anyoneoftheoffencesasmentionedunder'A'above, committedbyaparticularBidder/Contractor/Supplieronmorethanoneoccasion, beconsideredasSeconddegreeofoffence.

## Inadditiontothepenaltyofsuspension/debarment,thebidsecurity/earnestmoney postedbytheconcernedBidderorprospectiveBiddershallalsobeforfeited.

#### PENALTYFOROFFENCE:-

- (I) ForcommittingFirstdegreeofoffence: Disqualifying aBidderfromparticipating in anyprocurement processundertheAdministrative DepartmentofGovernmentof WestBengalupto2(two)years.
- (II) ForcommittingSeconddegreeof offence:DisqualifyingaBidderfrom participatingin anyprocurementprocessundertheAdministrativeDepartment ofGovernmentof WestBengalupto3(three)years.

## PROCEDURE OFSUSPENSION AND DEBARMENT DURING THE PROCUREMENT PROCESS

- (1) InitiationofAction, Notification and Hearings:
  - Any Bidder orprocurementauthority onhisown orbased onanyotherinformation madeavailabletohimmayinvitetheprocessof suspension/debarmentproceedings byfilingawrittenapplicationwiththe **BidEvaluationCommittee** and such filing of writtenapplicationhastobedonewithinforty eighthours from the date and time of publication of the result of technical evaluation of anybid.
  - (a) Uponverificationoftheexistenceofgroundsforsuspension/debarment,the Chairpersonof**BidEvaluation Committee**shallimmediatelynotifythebidder concernedeitherelectronicallythrough hisregisterede-mailor inwritingtohis postaladdress,advisinghimthat:
    - i) Acomplainthasbeenfiledagainst himandprimafaciematerialhasbeen found, which may lead to suspension / debarment.
    - ii)Hehasbeenrecommendedtobeplacedundersuspension/debarmentby thesuspensioncommittee(asconstituted bytherespectiveAdministrative Department)statingthegroundforsuch.
    - iii)Thesaid bidder, within three days from the date of issue of such notification by the BidEvaluation Committee, may approach the Chairperson of Suspension Committee by submitting all required documents in his favour for hearing. Any application made the reafter would not be entertained.

Such notice should contain the e-mail id and the postal address of the ChairpersonoftheSuspensionCommittee.

(b) Afterreceiving the recommendation forsuspensionfromBidEvaluation Committee, Suspension Committeeshallissueanoticetotheallegedbidder electronicallythroughhisregisterede-mailid,tosubmitallrelevantdocuments insupportofhisdefensewithinthreeworkingdays after issuanceofthe oftheSuspensionCommittee.TheSuspension Committeewillconductthe hearingwithinseven workingdaysfromthedate ofreceiptofthedocuments fromthealleged bidder. Ifnoappealhasbeenreceivedfromtheallegedbidder orifafterhearingsufficientgroundforsuspension isfound, the Suspension Committee, will suspend the alleged bidder from participating inthe procurement processundertheAdministrativeDepartmentforaperiodofsix monthsfromthedateofissuanceofsuspension order. The Chairperson of the

SuspensionCommitteeshallissuethesuspensionorderwithinsevendays fromthelastdateofhearingandshallnotifythebidderconcerned either electronicallythrough his registered e-mail id or in writing to his postal address. The Chairpersonof SuspensionCommitteeshall also inform the decisiontoallconcerned.

 $\label{lem:committee} If sufficient reason for suspension is not found, the Suspension Committee would reject the recommendation of Bid Evaluation Committee and would allow the bid dertotake part in the tendering process.$ 

If the bidder is suspended, the Suspension Committee would recommend debarment of the bidder and forward the case with all documents to the Debarment Committee for further action.

(c)TheDebarmentCommitteeuponreceiptoftherecommendation ofthe SuspensionCommitteeshallscrutinizethedocuments. TheDebarment Committee willholdahearingoftheallegedbidderandissuenecessary order withintenworking daysfromthelastdateofhearing.TheDebarment ifsatisfiedafterhearing, shall forward the case to the Department forordersofDebarment.TheDepartment induecoursewillissueDebarment Order disqualifying/prohibitingthe erring bidder from participatingin the bidding/procurementofallprojects undertheAdministrativeDepartmentfora specified period.Thealleged biddershallbeintimated accordingly electronicallythrough his registered e-mail id or in writing to his postal address.OtherwisetheDebarment Committeemayrejecttherecommendation oftheSuspensionCommittee. TheChairpersonofDebarment Committeeshall also inform the decision to all concerned.

### PROCEDUREFORDEBARMENTDURINGTHECONTRACTIMPLEMENTATIONSTAGE:-

- (A) Upontermination of contractduetodefaultof the Bidder, the Engineer-in-Chargeshall recommend for debarment of the Bid Evaluation Committee. The Bid Evaluation Committees hall submithis recommendation of debarment of the alleged Bidder along with a detailed reports tating clearly the reasons for debarment to the Debarment Committee within 30 (thirty) days from the date of termination of contract. The alleged Bidder shall be intimated accordingly either electronically to his registered e-mail idor in writing to his postal address. The Chair person of Bid Evaluation Committee shall also inform the decision to all concerned.
- (B) TheDebarmentCommitteeuponreceiptoftherecommendation ofBidEvaluation Committeeshallscrutinizethedocuments.TheDebarment Committeewillholda hearingaboutthematterfromtheBidderandissuenecessary orderwithin 10(ten) workingdaysfromthe last dateof hearing. The Debarment Committee, if satisfied after hearing, shall forward the case to the Department fortheorderofdebarment.The Department indue course will is sue debarment order disqualifying / prohibiting erringBidderfromparticipatinginthebidding/procurement ofallprojectsunderthe Administrative Department, GovernmentofWestBengalforaspecifiedperiod.The allegedBiddershallbeintimatedaccordinglyeitherelectronically tohisregisteredemailidorinwritingtohispostaladdress.OtherwisetheDebarment Committee may rejectthe recommendationof the Bid EvaluationCommittee.The Chairpersonof DebarmentCommitteeshallalsoinformthedecisiontoallconcerned.

### STATUSOFSUSPENDED/DEBARREDBIDDER:-

- (a) BidderplacedunderSuspension/Debarmentbythecompetentauthoritywillnotbe allowedtoparticipate inanyprocurement processundertheAdministrative Departmentwithintheperiodofsuspension/debarment. Theearnestmoneyofthe suspendedBiddershallstandforfeitedtotheGovernment.
- (b) IftheSuspension/DebarmentOrderisissuedpriortothedateofissueof"Letterof Acceptance", "Letter ofAcceptancecum Work Order", "Work Order", "Notice to Proceed", "AwardofContract" etc. foranyBid, the Suspended/DebarredBiddershall notbequalifiedforAwardforthesaidBidandsuchProcurementProcesswillbe dealtwithasper existingnorms by simply excluding the erring Bidder.
- (c) IftheSuspension/Debarment OrderisissuedafterawardofaGovernment Project/Contract totheDebarredBidder,theawardedProject/Contractshallnotbe prejudicedbythesaidOrderprovidedthatthesaidoffence(s)committed bythe DebarredBidderisnotconnectedwiththeawardedproject/contract.

**Clause42.**ExecutiveEngineeroftheconcernedDivisionwillbetheEngineer-in-Charge inrespect oftheTendercontractand allcorrespondencesconcerningrates,claims,change

inspecifications and/ordesignandsimilarimportantmatterswillbevalidonlyif accepted/recommendedbytheEngineer-in-Charge.Ifanycorrespondenceofabovetender ismadewithOfficersotherthantheEngineer-in-chargeforspeedvexecution ofworks, the samewillnotbevalidunlesscopiesaresenttotheEngineer-in-Chargeandalsoapproved byhim.InstructionsgivenbytheAssistant EngineerandtheJuniorEngineeronbehalfof the Engineer-in-Charge (who have been authorized to carry out the work on behalf of the Engineerregardingspecification, supervision, approval of materials and in-Charge) workmanshipshallalsobevalid. Incase of disputerelating to specification and work, the decisionofEngineer-in-Charge shallbefinalandbinding.TheEngineer-in-Charge howeverinvariablytakedecisionsrelatingtotendercontractorasmentionedinthe relevantrulesandclausesofthecontract document withtheapprovaloftheTender AcceptingAuthority.

**Clause43.**Acceptanceof the TenderwillrestwiththeTenderAcceptingAuthoritywithout assigning reasonthereof tothebidder.Theaccepting authorityreservestherighttoreject anyorall of thetenderswithoutassigninganyreasonthereoftothebidder/contractor.
